This should be followed by an extended abstract of up to 7 pages, which consists of a scholarly exposition of the paper's main ideas, results, and techniques, including motivation and a clear comparison with related work. All abstracts must contain the corresponding author's name and address.

Papers will be selected by a committee mainly composed of students enrolled in Vilfredo Pareto Doctoral Program in Economics, University of Turin.

The workshop will be held at the Collegio Carlo Alberto in Moncalieri, a medieval town near Torino.
